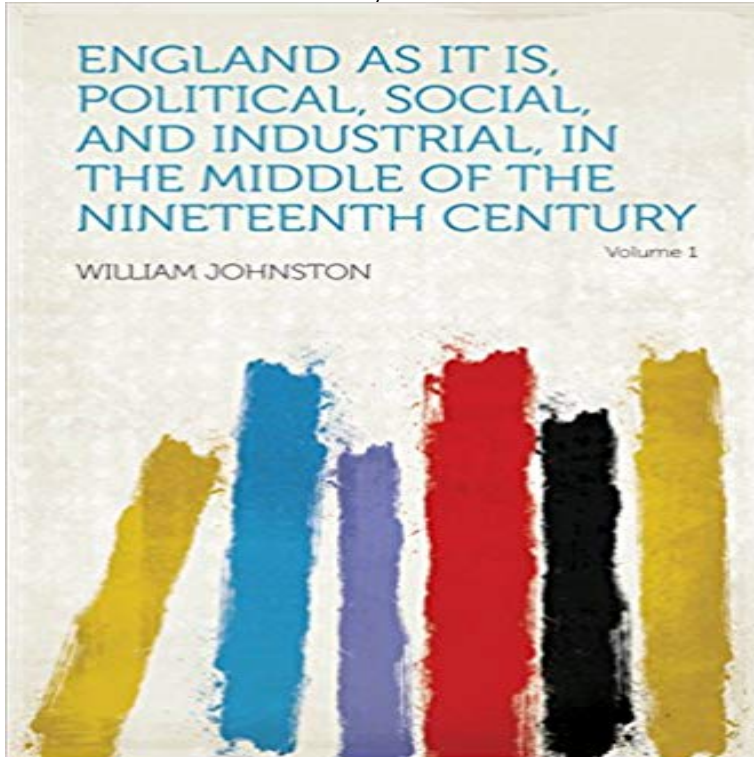


# England as It Is, Political, Social, and Industrial, in the Middle of the Nineteenth Century
