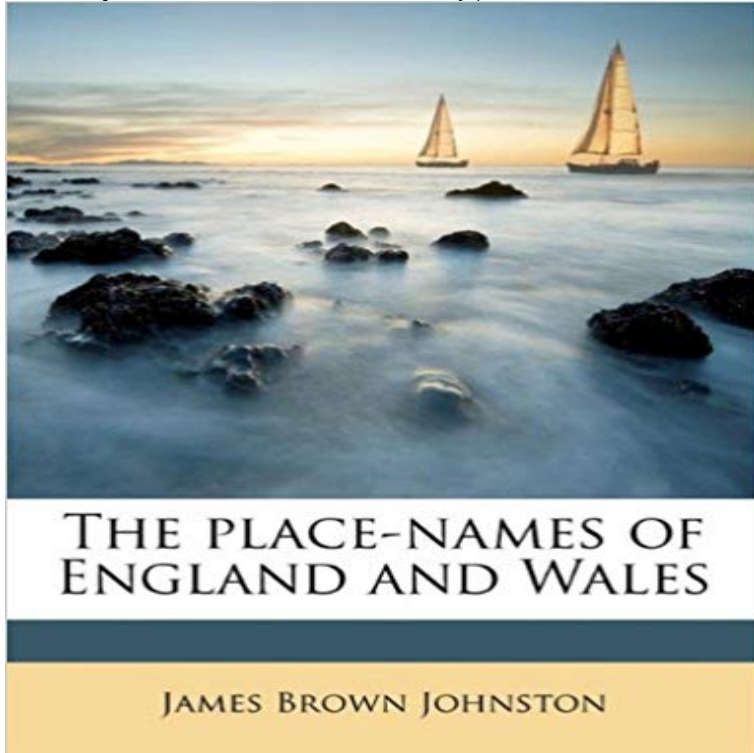


## The place-names of England and Wales
